THE MISSION OF THE SCHOOL



MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

The year 2012 marks the fifteenth anniversary of PLK Tong Nai Kan Junior Secondary College. Since its inception in 1997, the school has striven hard to provide quality education. In response to the implementation of the New Senior Secondary (NSS) Curriculum, the school has completed an education reform in quinquennium which values and promotes academic excellence and encourages students to develop their talents and potential to the full — "Achieving Academic Excellence, Nurturing Potential Talent".

Under the ceaseless efforts and the perseverance of our teachers, we have our school vision and mission realized. We can share our harmonious environment for students' gifted development in academic, sports and aesthetic pursuits. We can help students to lay solid foundations for further studied in the Sixth Form College, nurture them good communication skills and thinking skills, and help them to achieve excellence in studies. In the 2012 HKDSE Examination, more than one-third of the students have attained Grade 4 or above ; over 90% of the students have gained Grade 2 or above in most of the subjects, particularly, the passing rates of Physics and Mathematics Extended Part M1 are 100%. We are proud to see some students with brilliant results. There are 8 students getting Grade 5 or above in all subjects. One of them attained Grade 5** in Physics, Grade 5* in Biology and Chemistry, Grade 5 in Chinese Language, English Language, Mathematics and Liberal Studies and Grade A in Japanese. The most encouraging result is that over 40% of our first cohort students have gained the university entrance. This prestigious result gives the school the affirmation of our efforts in fostering the qualities of our students.

Although we have got a pleasing standard in academic achievement, we cannot be smug in this stage. The mission of the school should be further proceeded in the coming fifteen years so as to continue to equip our students to face the challenges of a fast



changing and increasingly competitive world. Therefore, there is absolutely a need to extend the boundaries of learning not just beyond the classrooms, but also outside Hong Kong. Other than the co-curricular life wide learning activities, students take part in overseas exchange programs and study tours which can enable them to develop an international perspective. It is true about the old Chinese saying, "Reading thousand volumes of books is not as good as walking thousands miles of journey". Exchange program is a different type of education which allows students to learn through their experiences sharing among partners coming from different places in the world. Study tours going to Shenzhen, Shanghai, Beijing, Korea and Singapore have been organized and we are planning to travel far and wide, like Australia and Britain, so as to widen our students' horizons.

We believe in bringing out the best in every student. In the coming future, the school will continue to offer students opportunities to grow and excel as independent youngsters. The school will value our traditions, Love, Respect, Diligence and Honesty, that have contributed to its success in the past. With this strong mission, we will leap forward and continue to make progress in providing a quality all-round education for the next generation in yet another fifteen years and beyond.




十五周年校慶暨通識主題 "Our Treasure, Our Future" 啟動禮






Project Learning
